Person Centered Reconciliation

Reconciliation of services means:

- Person centered planning occurs to help identify what the current needs and interests of people are. This is an opportunity for someone to change their services based on their current needs and interests and may be different from what they were receiving prior to the pandemic.
- Updating Life Plans accordingly.
- Submitting Service Amendments (SARFs) for new services, including permanentizing CH-R for those eligible and desiring in-residence CH-R.
 - Eligibility for in residence CH-R applies to elderly individuals (65+) or adults with medical frailty or presenting complex behavioral needs.
- For those eligible and interested in receiving in-residence CH-R, ensure that process steps an evaluation tool in 21-ADM-02 prior to submitting a SARF.

CCO Timeline

- By 6/30/23: Reconcile services for anyone who is living in a certified program who is potentially eligible for in-residence CH-R (7,255)
 - Prioritizing in order of Pre-Pandemic Services:
 1. Was receiving DH or PV outside of the home
 2. Was receiving DH in their residential setting
 3. Was receiving CH-R outside of the home
- By 8/1/23: Reconcile services for anyone who is not eligible for in-residence CH-R (11,188)
- By 9/1/23: Care Managers must engage in a person-centered planning process to assess appropriate day service moving forward and update any changes to the Life Plan accordingly

DH and PreVoc Provider Timeline

- Confirm day program preferences for anyone not eligible for in-residence CH-R living in a certified residence no later than 8/1/23
- If unable to support individuals' return and not closing the day program, issue due process no later than 8/30/23.
 - Due Process not submitted by 8/30/2023 will be confirmation that Day Provider intends to support individuals' residing in certified residential programs ability to return to Day Services post-PHE flexibility (11/12/23)

OPWDD Supporting Reconciliation

- Anyone with a SARF and NOD approval permanentizing their in-residence CH-R by 10/1/23 will be auto-enrolled in CH-R by OPWDD.
 - OPWDD will also auto-disenroll their DH/PreVoc services with the same effective date with notification to the DH/PreVoc Provider. (This will allow the provider to have the opportunity to use this capacity for other individuals needing DH or PreVoc services)
- Anyone without a SARF and NOD approval permanentizing their in-residence CH-R will be auto-disenrolled from their CH-R on 11/12/23.
